

Sample Script from "T-Shirt Shop" Grant We Applied For in August:

(Students line up in front of camera)

- Orlando--“Welcome to Estes Park Middle School! We have a great plan to help continue developing our STEAM program, as well as engage the entire school and our community, and we need your help.”
- Franco--“One thing we want is our own T-shirt shop. And with the Ricoh Ri 100 garment printing system, this will get us in the game at a reasonable cost.”
- Lizzie--“Students in Art and STEAM classes will learn graphic design, and put their creativity to work designing shirts for extra-curricular groups and teams...”

(Brita shows sample of artwork while Lizzie describes it)

- Franco--"We could sell these to those groups and teams at a much lower cost than what we currently pay for screen printing..."
- Brita--“And at the same time make enough profit to cover our costs of ordering more shirts and ink cartridges for the printer, so the program would become self-funding.”
- Lizzie--“The ideas are endless. For instance, near the end of the school year, we could have an annual “Design Challenge” for students to design the “school shirt” for the following year...
- Brita--“That way, every student would have the opportunity to show their school shirt on our “Purple Friday’s” with a student-

created shirt..."

- Franco--"And it would be done for minimal cost—about \$3.50-\$4.00 per shirt!"
- Orlando--"These are just a few of the possibilities that with your help, we could help serve a large number of the students not only in our Middle School, but our school district as well as our town. We appreciate any consideration you give to our project."
